# Partial Seams

#### **General Instructions**


All seams are 1/4". Press seams as directed.

### **Cutting Instructions**


- 1. From Fabric A (white), cut:
- 1 (one) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" square.
- 2. From each of Fabric B (green), Fabric C (yellow), Fabric D (orange), and Fabric E (brown), cut:
- 1 (one) 2" x 5" strip.

#### Construction


Place the 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" Fabric A square on top of the 2" x 5" Fabric C strip right sides together. Match the bottom edges. Sew halfway up the square. Press the seam towards the added strip.




Rotate the unit a quarter turn so the Fabric C strip is at the top. Stitch the 2" x 5" Fabric E strip onto the right-hand side. Press the seam towards the added strip.



Rotate the unit a quarter turn so the Fabric E strip is at the top. Stitch the 2" x 5" Fabric B strip onto the right-hand side. Press the seam towards the added strip.



Rotate the unit a quarter turn so the Fabric B strip is at the top. Fold the Fabric C strip out of the way and stitch the 2" x 5" Fabric D strip onto the right-hand side. Press the seam towards the added strip.



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Finish sewing the seam between Fabrics A, C, and D. Press the seam towards the first added strip.

The completed unit should measure 6-1/2" x 6-1/2".
