

Approximiately 51" x 17"

Skill Level

Assembly:

1. Make strip A by sewing block #3 and one setting triangle together, as shown. Press the seam toward the block.



Strip A


Materials Needed For Finishing:

For this block you will need:

- Painted Hearts blocks
- 2 side setting triangle squares
- Batting
- · Backing fabric
- · Binding strips

Cutting:

- 1. Trim each of the three appliquéd *Painted Hearts* blocks to measure 12-1/2" x 12-1/2". Use the original block layouts as a guide, if needed.
- 2. Cut each 12-7/8" x 12-7/8" side setting triangle




square in half **once** on the diagonal to make 4 side setting triangles, as shown. Handle these triangles carefully since they have bias edges that can easily stretch.

2. Make strip B by sewing block #2 and two setting triangles together, as shown. Press the seams toward the block.

3. Make strip C by sewing block #1 and one setting triangle together, as shown. Press the seam toward the block.
