One wall-sized quilt measuring 36" x 36" and another table topper challenge measuring 34" x 34". The **Color Options** table contains suggestions for color combinations, but don't limit yourself to just these options.

Part One

Choose three fabrics with good contrast for your **Take Me For A Spin** quilt. Don't limit yourself to solids, but very large prints are not recommended. One fabric will be the background. For a bold presentation, choose two other colors that are complementary on the color wheel. For a softer look, choose two analogous colors with less contrast.

Once you've selected your fabrics, refer to the **Take Me For A Spin Fabric Requirements** table below for the exact yardages for the size quilt you are making.

This month, we will cut strips, make strip sets, and subcut them into rectangle units. Make a storage and labeling plan now to keep everything organized.

Take Me For A Spin Mystery Fabric Requirements: Not suitable for directional or striped fabrics.

Fabric	Fabric Requirements		
Background	2-1/4 yds		
Color #1	1 yd		
Color #2	1 yd		
Binding	2/3 yd		
Backing	40" x 40" piece and 38" x 38" piece		
Batting	40" x 40" piece and 38" x 38" piece		
Special Tools Required: 12-1/2" square ruler with 45-degree lines. Spray starch.			

Cutting:

Since you will be working with bias edges, starch and press your fabrics very well before cutting to help avoid stretching later when piecing.

Referring to the *Take Me For A Spin* Cutting and Labeling table below, cut each fabric into the number of pieces required for the size quilt you are making. It is **very important** to group and label the pieces as they are cut. Note that a number of strip sizes are repeated in different color combinations.
