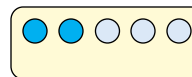

## Materials List

40"- 42" wide, 100% cotton prewashed fabrics recommended

### Freezer Paper Appliqué Method

- 3/4 yd light beige fabric for background
- 5/8 yd red fabric for hearts, inside border, small knot, bow lining, and binding
- 1-1/3 yds print fabric for outside border and backing
- 1 fat quarter green fabric for bow and inside center knot
- 1/2 yd freezer paper
- 1/2 yd medium weight stabilizer
- 33" x 33" batting
- Fine point permanent marker
- Quilter's erasable pen
- Matching thread
- Appliqué needle of your choice
- Liquid starch
- Thin small brush (Lipstick or eyeliner brush works.)
- Small bowl for starch

### Fused Appliqué Method

- 3/4 yd light beige fabric for background
- 5/8 yd red fabric for hearts, inside border, small knot, bow lining, and binding.
- 1-1/3 yds print fabric for outside border and backing
- 1 fat quarter green fabric for bow and inside center knot
- 1/2 yd 18" wide paper-backed fusible web or 4 printable fusible web sheets
- 1/2 yd medium weight stabilizer if machine stitching
- 33" x 33" batting
- Fine point permanent marker
- Quilter's erasable pen
- Matching thread
- Pressing sheet
