Part 1

General Instructions

All seams are 1/4" unless otherwise noted. Press seams as directed. Label units as they are completed to avoid confusion later in the construction.

Making the Units

Cutting


- 1. From Fabric A, cut
- 10 (ten) 4-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut into 80 (eighty) 4-3/4" x 4-3/4" squares. (Unit A)
- 2. From Fabric B, cut
 - 23 (twenty-three) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut into 160 (one hundred sixty) 3" x 5" rectangles. (Unit A)
 - 10 (ten) 4-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut into 80 (eighty) 4-3/4" x 4-3/4" squares. (Unit B)
- 3. From Fabric C. cut
 - 23 (twenty-three) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut into 160 (one hundred sixty) 3" x 5" rectangles. (Unit B)


Making the Foundation Units

- 1. Locate the **701 Mystery** Foundation Templates in the PDF file associated with this issue of the magazine. Print the number of copies needed as noted on each page onto lightweight foundation paper. Cut out each foundation template 1/2" beyond the long dashed line.
- 2. Fabric colors are noted on each segment of the foundation templates. Your fabric color choices may vary. For easier reference, make a note of your choices with respect to the pattern.
- 3. Change your machine stitch length to a 1.6 mm stitch or as close to that as you can to make your stitches small. It helps when it is time to remove the foundation papers.
- 4. Using the prepared foundation papers, paper piece each template. Using the colors as a guide to your fabric selections, begin with the lowest number segment. Pin or use temporary glue to hold the fabric and paper together.
- 5. After stitching each segment on the solid line, use a 5" x 8" index card to fold back the paper.
- 6. Trim the units on the dashed line to 4-1/2" x 4-1/2".



2. Layer a marked 2-7/8" x 2-7/8" Fabric B square

with a 2-7/8" x 2-7/8" Fabric C square, right sides

together. Stitch a 1/4" seam on each side of the diagonal line. Cut along the drawn line. Press seams

Unit 3

Cutting

From Fabric B, cut

- 2 (two) 2-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut 21 (twentyone) 2-7/8" x 2-7/8" squares.
- 3 (three) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut 42 (forty-two) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares.

From Fabric C, cut

2 (two) 2-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut 21 (twenty-one) 2-7/8" x 2-7/8" squares.


Making the Unit

1. On the back of 21 (twenty-one) 2-7/8" x 2-7/8" Fabric B squares, draw a line along one diagonal.



Mark 21

3. Stitch a B/C HST and a 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" Fabric B square together to make Unit 3 as shown. Press seam open. Make 42. Unit 3 should measure 2-1/2" x 4-1/2".
