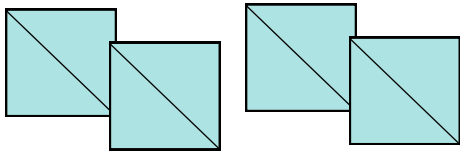


NO WASTE FLYING GEESE

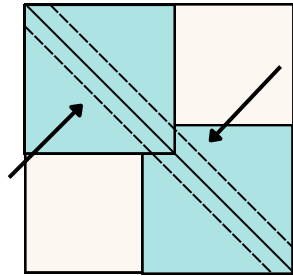

If you love efficiency (and who doesn't?), the no waste method for making Flying Geese is a total game changer! Instead of sewing and trimming each unit individually, this technique allows you to create four Flying Geese at once, with no fabric waste and perfect points every time. It's quick, tidy, and ideal for building your confidence with precision piecing. Once you try it, you'll wonder why you ever made them any other way!

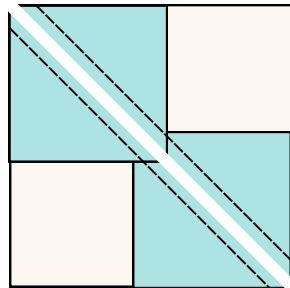
Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 4 fabric squares.



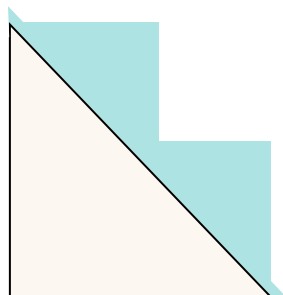
Arrange 2 small squares in opposite corners of the large square, right sides together. Sew 1/4" away from the marked line on each side.



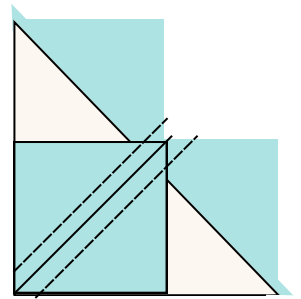
Cut on the diagonally marked line.



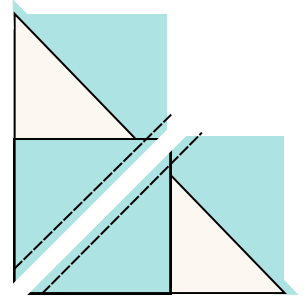
Press triangles and seam allowance outward. Complete 2 units.



Arrange a small square per diagram and sew 1/4" away from the marked line on each side. Complete 2 units.



Trim along marked line. Press triangle outward and seam allowance towards the rectangle. Complete 4 units.



Cut off the ears as shown in diagram.
